It concerns information which is not collected in order to be associated with an identified data subject, but which, given the data's nature, could, through processing and being associated with data held by third parties, allow users to be identified.

This category of data includes IP addresses or domain names of the computers used by users who connect to the site, addresses in URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) form of the requested resources, the times of the requests, the method used to make the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response given by the server (success, error, etc.) as well as other parameters related to the user's operating system and computer environment.

This data is only used to obtain anonymous statistical information on how the site is used and to check that the site performs properly and the data is deleted immediately after it is processed.

Data supplied voluntarily by users

The optional, explicit and voluntary transmission of personal data by users through registration forms found on this site leads to the subsequent acquisition of data supplied by the sender and this data is needed to provide the service requested. Specific summary information will be progressively reported or displayed on the site's pages prepared for particular services on request.

COOKIES

Cookies are small text files which contain a certain amount of information which is exchanged between an internet site and the user's device (usually the browser) with which the user browses the internet. Cookies are mainly used to make websites work and to make them more efficient, as well as providing information to the website owners. There are two types of cookie: session and persistent. Session cookies are stored on the user's device for a short period of time and are deleted when the user closes their web browser. Their use is strictly limited to transmitting session identifiers (made up of random numbers generated by the server) which are needed to allow the site to be browsed securely and efficiently. Persistent cookies, on the other hand, stay saved on the user's device until a pre-set expiry date and time is reached. These cookies, not being cancelled immediately upon closing the browser, allow the user's options regarding the website to be saved and allow information to be collected on which pages the user has visited, the frequency with which the user visits the site, and allow the user's browsing history to be tracked, in order to improve the user's experience on the site. Cookies, whether session or persistent, can also be "First-party" or "Third-party". First-party cookies are those saved on the user's device by the same body that owns the website being browsed by the user. Third-party cookies are those saved on the user's device by someone not running the website being browsed by the user.

THE OPTION OF PROVIDING DATA

Apart from that specified for browsing data, the user is free to supply his/her personal data. However, if the user should decide not to provide his/her data, it may mean that it is impossible to adequately respond to his/her requests.



MEANS OF PROCESSING DATA AND THE LENGTH OF TIME THAT THE DATA WILL BE STORED

Personal data is processed, including through the use of automated tools, for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which the data was collected. Once the specific management, statistical, commercial, promotional, advertising purposes relative to the Data Controller's processing of the data have been achieved, the data will be stored for tax and civil purposes in accordance with the law.

Specific security measures are observed in order to prevent any loss of data, illegal and improper uses, and any unauthorised access.

The Data Controller has adopted the minimum security measures as provided for by law and based on the main international standards. The Data Controller has also adopted other security measures in order to minimise the risks regarding the confidentiality, availability and the integrity of the personal data collected and processed.

SHARING, COMMUNICATION AND DIVULGING DATA

The data collected may be transferred or communicated to other companies for activities strictly connected and instrumental to the provision of the service, such as managing the information systems. Personal data supplied by users who request that informational material be sent to them (brochures, informational material, etc.) is used solely for the purposes of providing the service or fulfilling the request and the data is communicated to third parties only in the event in which this is necessary (companies who provide packaging, labelling and shipping services). Outside of these cases, personal data will not be communicated to any other party unless stipulated by contract or by law, or unless specifically requested by the data subject.

In this sense, personal data could be transmitted to third parties, but only and exclusively in one or more of the following cases:

1. there is explicit consent to share data with third parties;
2. there is a need to share information with third parties in order to provide the service requested;
3. it is necessary in order to comply with requests from a judicial body or public security body.
